CARES-Act Tablet Distribution

Eastern Carolina Council's Area Agency on Aging (ECC-AAA) Ombudsman Program was awarded CARES-Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) funds to assist residents in long-term care facilities. Social isolation has been a critical challenge during the pandemic and the ECC-AAA Ombudsman Program used CARES-Act funds to purchase electronic tablets to help residents stay in touch virtually with family, friends, and Ombudsmen. Since skilled nursing facilities were eligible to obtain assistive devices through Civil Money Penalty (CMP) grants, the Ombudsman Program focused on family care home and adult care home residents. All family care homes and adult care homes region-wide were offered tablets.

Collectively, fifty-nine tablets were obtained and programmed with the video call programs Skype and Zoom, with facilities caring for more than thirty residents receiving two tablets. The Ombudsmen programmed the tablets with facility-specific emails and provided the tablets to facilities ready to be used. Detailed instructions on how to invite family and friends to join video calls were provided to facility staff as well as guidelines on how to secure the tablets when not in use. The tablets were delivered with Ombudsmen contact information already entered in and can be monitored remotely by Ombudsmen staff.

To ensure security, tablets for family care homes with six residents or less were protected by locked holders connected to security cords. For all other facilities, the tablets were secured in wheeled kiosks to enable the tablets to be secured and portable through larger facilities. The facility staff were encouraged to assist residents with calls at-will and are not required to return the tablets once the public health emergency has ended. Much appreciation was voiced by facility staff members, many who were using personal devices to connect residents with family and friends.
