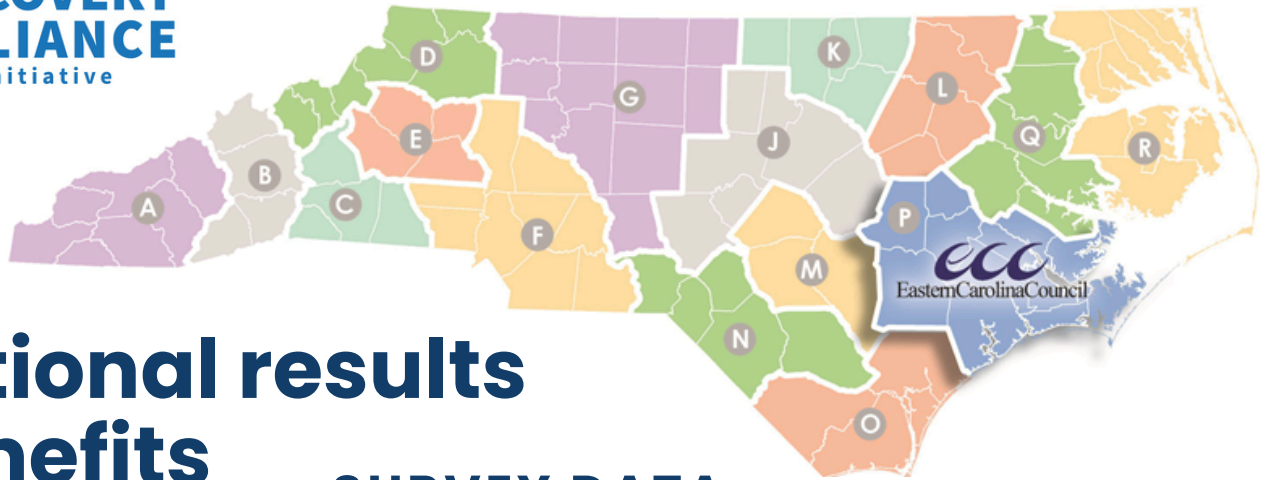
THE GOAL
