

Family Caregiver Support Program Request for Funding

INVITATION FOR BID NOTIFICATION

The Eastern Carolina Council of Governments (ECC) is soliciting bids from qualified organizations to provide services to eligible caregivers under the Older Americans Act Title III-E Family Caregiver Support Program. Services will be provided for the contract period of **July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027**, within the following counties: Carteret, Craven, Duplin, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, Onslow, Pamlico, and Wayne. Selected providers will deliver services in accordance with all applicable federal and state requirements and in compliance with written policies and procedures established by the North Carolina Division of Aging.

Services funded through this program must be provided to individuals meeting one or more of the following eligibility categories:

- **Family Caregivers of Older Adults:**
Individuals of any age who provide unpaid care to an older adult aged 60 or older, or who provide care to an individual with Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia.
- **Older Adults as Caregivers (Kinship Caregivers):**
A relative caregiver (not a parent), aged 55 or older, who is living with and raising a relative child aged 18 or younger; or a relative or parent aged 55 or older who is living with and providing care for an adult child (ages 19–59) with a disability.

Organizations with demonstrated experience serving caregivers and older adults are encouraged to apply. Completed proposals are due to ECCAAA by no later than 5pm on May 29, 2026.
